Messe Augsburg and Phaesun GmbH hand over proceeds from Off-Grid Sales to ARCHEMED

Next international Off-Grid event to be held in November

Augsburg. At the beginning of February, managing director of Messe Augsburg Thomas Schmidt-Tancredi and Phaesun managing director Tobias Zwirner handed over the proceeds from donated Off-Grid products to Dr Ulrich Markmiller from ARCHEMED - Doctors for Children in Need.

In addition to Phaesun products, manufacturers German Offgrid Power and Studer Innotec also donated products, thus generating the donation together with Messe Augsburg, the organisers of Off-Grid Sales. The products were sold last year during the Off-Grid Experts Workshop in Augsburg. "We are delighted that with the proceeds we can support ARCHEMED's humanitarian aid in Eritrea", explains Phaesun managing director Tobias Zwirner. The sale raised a total of 1,000 euros.

About ARCHEMED – Ärzte für Kinder in Not e.V.:

The non-profit association *ARCHEMED - Ärzte für Kinder in Not e.V.* was founded by Dr Peter Schwidtal in the German county town of Soest in 2010. Its overriding aim is to improve the lives of children in Eritrea by providing medical and humanitarian aid. The numerous projects it supports and the clinic buildings it finances ensure that the Eritrean children (and thus also their families) receive sustainable aid. Volunteer teams of doctors, nurses and technicians work to this end on site in Eritrea: not only

in the capital Asmara, but in the meantime also in four additional provincial hospitals. As well as a broad range of surgical and non-surgical procedures, their core competence is in perinatal medicine, i.e. safe birth support and care of new-born and premature babies. ARCHEMED also sees its mission in the sustainable and consistent training of local doctors and nurses in hands-on patient treatment, i.e. training where it is needed, so that such knowledge transfer will, in the long term, make ARCHEMED's further involvement superfluous.

This year, the international event for self-sufficient power supply will take place on 5 and 6 November under the new name OFF-GRID Expo + Conference. The day before, participants can attend product training sessions at a special TechDay. The OFF-GRID Conference will take place parallel to the exhibition and the interactive supporting programme with hands-on workshop, speed dating and after-show event. Here, experts will explain the latest trends and present project examples from the fields of mini and micro-grids, system design and electricity storage as well as solar, wind and hydro power.

The OFF-GRID Expo + Conference is aimed at all players involved with self-sufficient power supply - including industry, tradesmen, installers, dealers or project planners, employees of aid organisations, universities or public administration.
